North Wales Choral Festival is a hit

THE North Wales Choral Festival was held during November 4-6 in Venue Cymru, Llandudno.

Now in its 29th year, this year was the busiest festival to date with over 50 choirs flocking to Llandudno, which is over 2,000 choir members! Choirs from Poland, Holland, Ireland and all over the UK and Northern Ireland competed.

The event opened on Friday with North Wales junior and senior school choirs competing, as well as a choral workshop. Cór Ffrindiau Ysgolion Eglwys Trefnant & Llanbedr won the junior category, with Ysgol Melyd coming second, and Southdown Primary School third. Ysgol Maes Garmon came first in the senior category, Ysgol Gader second and Alun School Choir third, all who took part were highly commended.

Crowds of people were also entertained at the festival on Saturday with The Daleian Singers winning the Male Voice choir competition, Cór Bro Aled taking 2nd and our friends from Poland - Górniczy Chór Męski (Male miner's choir) coming third. Llywth Y Llan took first place in the youth competition, Cór Ieuencid Mon were second place and Cantabile Youth Choir came third. Finally for the Saturday competitions it was the Ladies turn with Entourage winning, The Chanterelles second and Opus 44 placed third.

Sunday's competition's welcomed the brand new category - Just for Fun which saw community and charity choirs compete for first, second and third with Dun Laoghaire Musical and Dramatic Society taking first

place, Vivacity second and Cór Dewi Sant third. It was then onto the dazzling Barbershop choirs with Cheshire Chord Company once again coming first, Crystal Chords second and Sheffield Harmony third.

The Mixed voice competition saw 10 choirs compete. Nottingham Trent University took first place, Friday Voices came second and Cór Bro Meirion third.
